An Act to enable the Governor in Council to declare the Shire of Keilor the Shire of Mulgrave and the Shire of Springvale and Noble Park respectively to be Cities.

[13th December, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Local Government (Keilor Waverley and Springvale) Act 1960*.

(2) The *Local Government Act 1958* as amended is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

2. Notwithstanding anything in section sixteen of the Principal Act the Governor in Council may declare the shire of Keilor the shire of Mulgrave and the shire of Springvale and Noble Park respectively to be cities under the respective names of the City of Keilor the City of Waverley and the City of Springvale, and for and in relation to that purpose Part II. of the Principal

Act

Act shall with all necessary adaptations be read and construed accordingly ; and, in particular, without affecting the generality of the foregoing, the said Act shall be read and construed and have effect as if—

- (a) in sub-section (1) of section thirty-four after the words “ declaring any shire a borough ” there were inserted the words “ or city ” ;
- (b) the power conferred on the Governor in Council by this Act were a power exercisable under paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section thirty-five ; and
- (c) in sub-paragraph (iv) of paragraph (a) of sub-section (1) of section thirty-six for the word “ borough ” (wherever occurring) there were substituted the word “ shire ” .
