An Act to amend Section Fourteen of the *Medical Act* 1928.

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Medical (Registration) Act* 1953 and shall be read and construed as one with the *Medical Act* 1928 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act amending the same all of which Acts and this Act may be cited together as the Medical Acts.

2. In paragraph (b) of section fourteen of the Principal Act as amended by any Act after the word "examination" there shall be inserted the expression "(whether or not subject to any requirement for further hospital experience)".
