An Act to increase Certain Penalties in the *Margarine Act 1958*.

[6th November, 1968.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Margarine (Penalties) Act 1968*.

(2) In this Act the *Margarine Act 1958* is called the Principal Act.

(3) The several provisions of this Act shall come into operation on a day or the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.
