An Act relating to the Coming into Operation of the Provisions of the *Motor Car Act 1959*.

[3rd May, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Motor Car (Commencement) Act 1960*.

Amendment of No. 6563 s. 1.

2. For sub-section (3) of section one of the *Motor Car Act 1959* there shall be substituted the following sub-section:—

Provision for proclamation of commencement of different provisions of No. 6563 on different days.

“(3) The several provisions of this Act shall come into operation on a day or on the respective days to be fixed by proclamation or successive proclamations of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette*.”
