No. 6795.

An Act to provide for the Imposition of a Surcharge upon Insurance Premiums paid in respect of Contracts of Insurance entered into pursuant to Part V. of the *Motor Car Act* 1958.

[28th November, 1961.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Motor Car (Insurance Surcharge) Act* 1961. Short title.

(2) In this Act the *Motor Car Act* 1958 is called the Principal Act.
