An Act to amend the Pawnbrokers Act 1958.

[12th December, 1961.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Pawnbrokers* (Amendment) Short title. Act 1961.
- (2) In this Act the *Pawnbrokers Act* 1958 is called the Principal Principal Act Act.
- 2. Section twenty-six of the Principal Act shall be amended as follows:—
 - (a) For the expression "Five shillings" (wherever occurring in the section) there shall be substituted the expression "Five pounds"; and
 - (b) In paragraph (b) of sub-section (3) for the expression "Ten shillings" there shall be substituted the expression "Five pounds".
