## An Act to amend Sections Three and Five of the Swine Act 1928.

[19th June, 1945.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the Swine Act 1945 and shall be read and construed as one with the Swine Act 1928 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) and any Act and enactment amending the same all of which Acts and enactments and this Act may be cited together as the Swine Acts.
