An Act to amend the South Africa Contingents Pensions Act 1905.

[20th November, 1906.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

- 1. This Act shall be called and may be cited as the South Africa Short title. Contingents Pensions Act 1906.
- 2. All pensions payable in pursuance of the South Africa Pensions payable Contingents Pensions Act 1905 and this Act shall be paid out of the quarterly in advance.
- 3. The Second Schedule to the South Africa Contingents Pensions Second Sched. No. Act 1905 shall be amended to the extent mentioned in the Schedule to 1997 amended. this Act.
