An Act to authorize and empower the State Electricity Commission of Victoria to construct maintain and operate a Hydro-Electric Power Station on the Mitta Mitta River.

[28th November, 1972.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *State Electricity Commission (Dartmouth Hydro-Electric Power Station) Act 1972*.

Commencement.

(2) The *State Electricity Commission Act 1958* is in this Act called the Principal Act.

(3) This Act shall come into operation on a day to be fixed by proclamation of the Governor in Council published in the *Government Gazette* which proclamation may be made when the Governor in Council is satisfied that the governments of the

Commonwealth

Commonwealth and the States of New South Wales and South Australia have expressed concurrence with the proposed Dartmouth Hydro-Electric Power Station project.

2. After section 15 of the Principal Act there shall be inserted the following section :—

New section
15A.

“ 15A. (1) The Commission is hereby authorized and empowered to construct maintain and operate a hydro-electric power station with a capacity of 150 megawatts on the Mitta Mitta River below the Dartmouth Dam and to do all such acts matters and things as are necessary or expedient to incorporate the generating capacity of that power station into the electricity supply system of the Commission.

(2) The power station and other works authorized under sub-section (1) shall, for the purposes of this Act, be an electrical undertaking of the Commission and be deemed to be an electrical undertaking approved by the Governor in Council.”
