An Act to make Provision with respect to a Scheme for the Extension of the State Electricity Generating System by the Extension of the Generating Station of the State Electricity Commission of Victoria known as Yallourn W Power Station.

[28th November, 1972.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *State Electricity Commission (Yallourn W Power Station) Act 1972*.

(2) The *State Electricity Commission Act 1958* is in this Act called the Principal Act.

2. After sub-section (4) of section 15 of the Principal Act there shall be inserted the following sub-section :—

Extension of
Yallourn W
Power Station.

“(5) The scheme for the extension of the Yallourn W Power Station (which is more particularly described in the Report of the Commission

Commission dated 31st August, 1972 on the extension of Yallourn W Power Station from a capacity of 700 megawatts to 1,400 megawatts furnished to the Minister and laid on the table of each House of Parliament) is hereby declared to have been approved by the Governor in Council but such approval shall not be deemed to prevent the Commission from making such departures from the details of the scheme as appear from time to time to be necessary or expedient."
