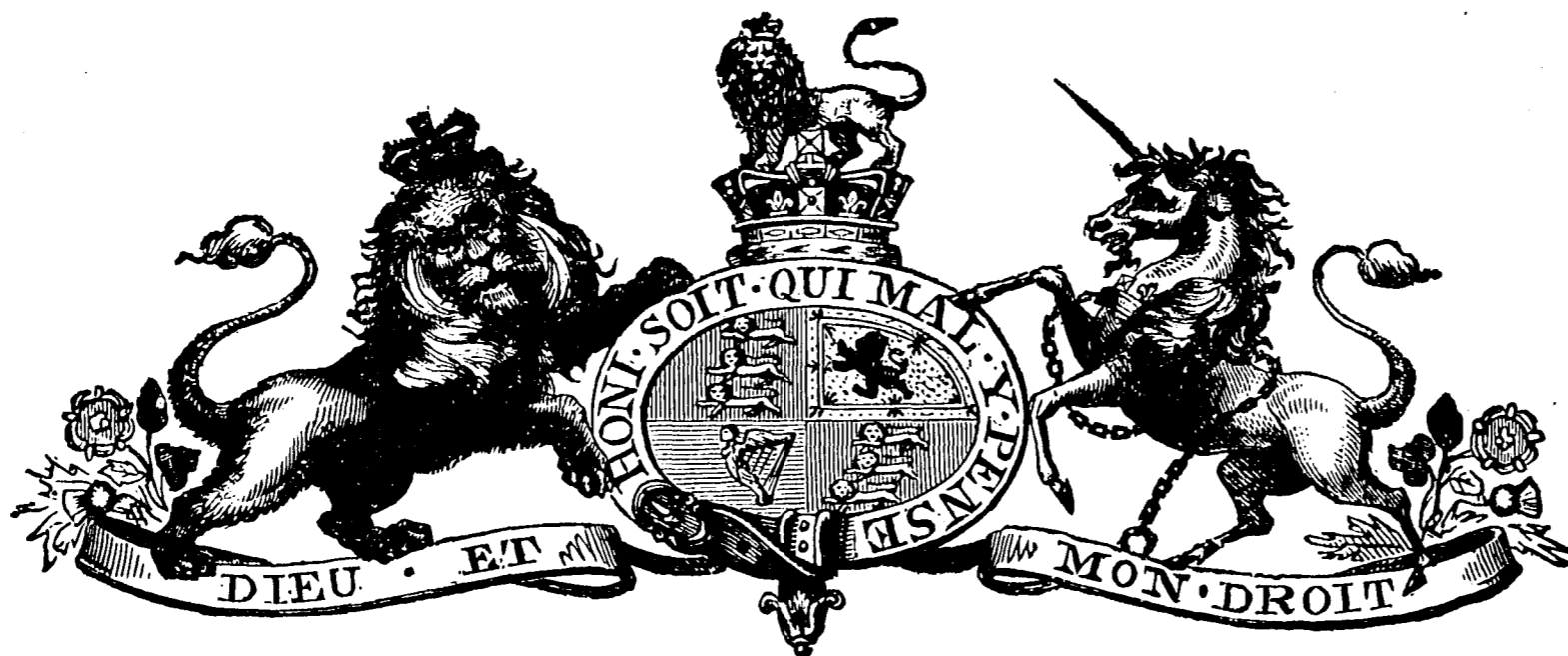

No. 1310.

An Act to authorize the City of Saint Kilda to construct certain permanent Works and Undertakings in lieu of certain other permanent Works and Undertakings.

[29th August, 1893.]

WHEREAS pursuant to the provisions of the *Local Government Act* 1874 and the *Local Government Act* 1890 and in accordance with notices dated the fourteenth day of December One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven and the twenty-second day of January One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one respectively and advertised in the *Government Gazette* on the sixteenth day of December One thousand eight hundred and eighty-seven and the twenty-third day of January One thousand eight hundred and ninety-one respectively the Council of the City of Saint Kilda by the sale of debentures borrowed the sums of One hundred thousand pounds and Twenty-five thousand pounds respectively secured upon the municipal revenues of the mayor councillors and burgesses of the said city : And whereas in the said notices it was set forth that the purposes to which the said loans were to be applied included amongst other things the amount of Fourteen thousand three hundred and seventy-three pounds five shillings and eightpence for expenditure for the purposes set forth in the First Schedule to this Act: And whereas the said amount is not now required for the purposes set forth in the said First Schedule but is required for the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Act : And whereas it is expedient to enable such amount to be so applied with the consent of the holders of the said debentures unless forbidden so to do by the ratepayers of the said city : Be it therefore enacted

by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *Saint Kilda Loan Act 1893*.

Construction.

2. This Act shall be construed as one with the *Local Government Act 1890* as amended by the *Local Government Act 1891*.

Saint Kilda Council may make special order altering application of portion of loan.

3. (1) Subject to the following provisions the Council of the City of Saint Kilda may make a special order declaring that all or any specified part of the money borrowed for the purposes set forth in the First Schedule to this Act shall be applied for all or any of the purposes set forth in the Second Schedule to this Act and specified in such special order.

Consent of debenture-holders necessary.

(2) No such special order shall be made until the holders of all debentures sold for the purposes of the said loans have in writing signified their approval of such proposed alteration of the application of the proceeds of such loans.

Special order no effect until confirmed.

(3) No such special order shall have any force or effect unless confirmed at a subsequent meeting of the Council, and unless at such meeting the resolution for such confirmation is carried by a majority of the whole number of members of the Council.

Special order not to be confirmed until advertised nor if forbidden by ratepayers.

(4) No such special order shall be so confirmed unless the Council shall at least two months previously have published in the *Government Gazette* and also twice in some newspaper generally circulating in the municipal district of Saint Kilda a notice of their intention to confirm such special order and are not forbidden from confirming such special order by ratepayers whose votes form one-third of the number of votes for which voters are inscribed on the municipal roll of the said municipality.

Mode in which ratepayers may forbid confirmation of special order.

(5) Within one month after the publication of such notice any twenty persons whose names are inscribed on the municipal roll may by writing under their hands delivered to the chairman or clerk of the municipality together with a sum of Twenty pounds demand that the question whether or not such special order be confirmed be submitted to the election of the ratepayers; and thereupon the votes of the ratepayers shall be taken upon the question accordingly in as nearly as possible the like manner as the votes of ratepayers desiring to forbid a Council from proceeding further with a loan are taken under Part XI. of the *Local Government Act 1890*, and the said Part and the Nineteenth Schedule of the said Act shall be read and construed with such substitutions as may be necessary for such purpose and any reference in such Part or Schedule to the forbidding of a loan shall be deemed and taken to refer to the forbidding of the confirmation of a special order as aforesaid.
