An Act to apply the Surplus Revenue for the Financial Year ended on the Thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and sixty.

[29th November, 1960.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the Surplus Revenue Act 1960.

Application of surplus for 1959-60. See No. 6345 s. 20. 2. The sum of Three hundred and thirteen thousand five hundred and thirty-seven pounds eleven shillings and fourpence being excess of receipts on account of the Consolidated Revenue over expenditure out of the Consolidated Revenue for the year ended on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and sixty shall be applied out of the Surplus Revenue Account and appropriated to the Revenue Account of the year ending on the thirtieth day of June One thousand nine hundred and sixty-one.
