

An Act to amend the Thistle Act 1890.

[6th November, 1893.]

E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):-

1. This Act may be cited as the Thistle Act 1893, and shall be short title and construed as one with the Thistle Act 1890.

2. The Thistle Act 1891 is hereby repealed, but the operation of Repeal of Act any proclamation heretofore published thereunder shall not be affected by such repeal.

3. The Governor in Council may at any time by a proclamation in the Government Gazette declare any plant to be a "thistle" within the meaning of the Thistle Act 1890, and may by such proclamation extend such declaration to the whole of the colony of Victoria or limit the same to such portion or portions of the colony as are specified in such proclamation, and after the publication of such proclamation the word "thistle" in the Thistle Act 1890 shall either throughout Victoria or within the portion or portions of the colony specified as aforesaid (as the case may be) be deemed to include any plant named in such proclamation.

Governor in Council may declare any plant to be a "thistle."
