An Act to amend the Treasury Bills and Advances Act 1922.

[30th November, 1923.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title construction and citation. No. 3200.

1. This Act may be cited as the Treasury Bills and Advances Act 1923 and shall be read and construed as one with the Treasury Bills and Advances Act 1922 (hereinafter called the Principal Act) which Act and this Act may be cited together as the Treasury Bills and Advances Acts.

- 2. The Principal Act is hereby amended as follows:-
 - (a) In sections four, six, eight, nine, ten and thirteen after the word "interest" (wherever occurring) there shall be inserted the words "if any";
 - (b) In section six after the words "advance under this Act" there shall be inserted the words "and the discount charged on any Treasury bill"; and
 - (c) In section seven the words "at any price not less than the par face value thereof" are hereby repealed.
