## No. DCCCXLVII.

An Act to further amend an Act intituled "An Act for Hospitals and Charitable Institutions."

**D**E it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may for all purposes be cited as "The Hospitals and Short title and Charitable Institutions Amending Act 1885," and shall be read and construed with the Act intituled "An Act for Hospitals and Charitable Institutions" hereinafter referred to as "the Principal Act."

2. Any institution society or association incorporated under the Power of institutions Principal Act may with the sanction of a majority of the contributors for the time being to such institution society or association present at a public meeting convened in accordance with the provisions of section five of the Principal Act change its corporate style and title and adopt any other corporate style and title, every such change shall be submitted for his approval to the Governor in Council, and when approved by him shall be notified in the Government Gazette, and the new style and title so adopted shall be thereupon deemed to be the corporate style and title

societies and associations to change style and title.

title of such institution society or association for all purposes whatsoever; but no such change of style and title shall affect any rights or obligations of such institution society or association or render defective any legal proceedings instituted or to be instituted by or against such institution society or association, and any legal proceedings may be continued or commenced against such institution society or association by its new corporate style and title that might have been continued or commenced against such institution society or association by its former corporate style and title.
