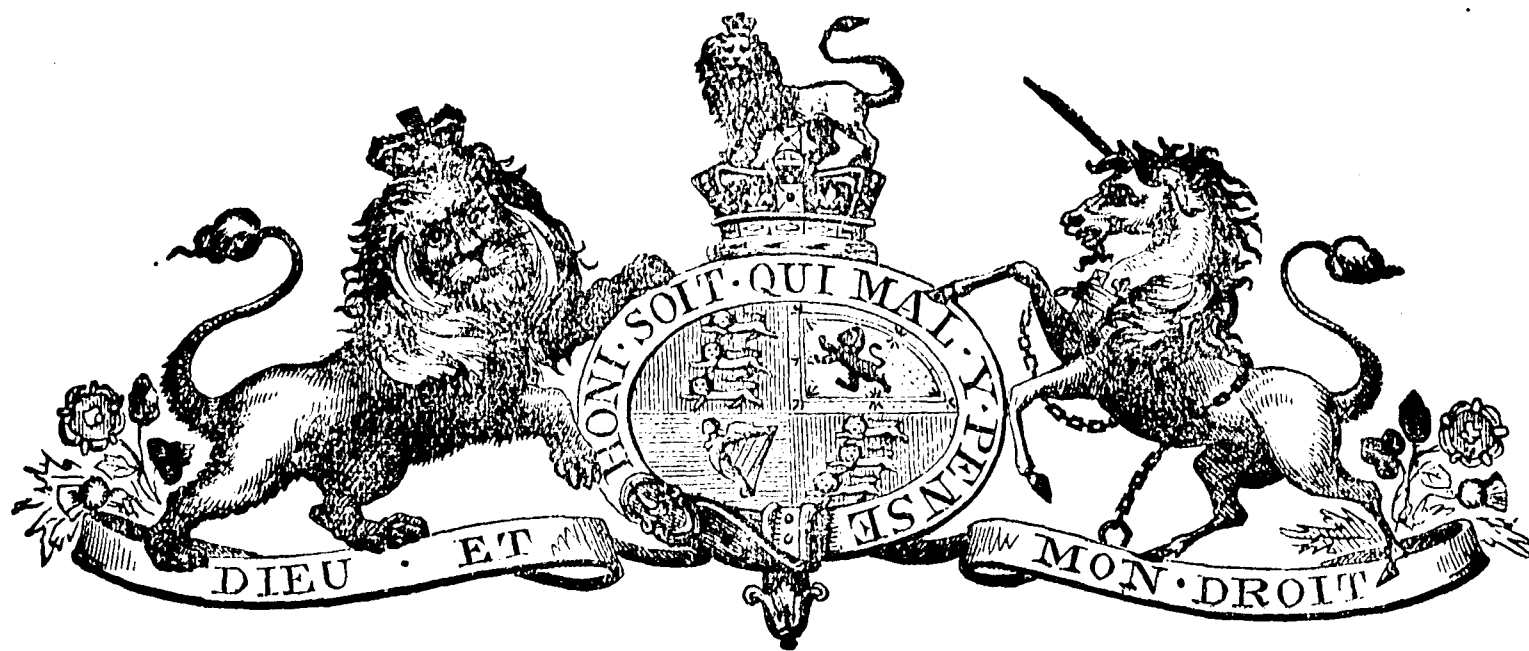

No DCCCCXCIII.

An Act to further amend "*The Residence Areas Act 1881.*"

[20th December 1888.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may for all purposes be cited as "*The Residence Areas Act 1888*" and shall be read and construed as part of "*The Residence Areas Act 1881*" as amended by "*The Residence Areas Act 1884*" and with these Acts shall be read and construed as one with the "*Mining Statute 1865.*"

2. Any holder of a miner's right or business licence who has under the provisions of "*The Residence Areas Act 1884*" the exclusive right to purchase the land occupied by virtue of such miner's right or business licence by him shall be entitled on exercising such right of purchase to pay the amount of the purchase money in ten annual instalments of equal amount.

Holder of a miner's right or business licence may pay for residence area in instalments.
