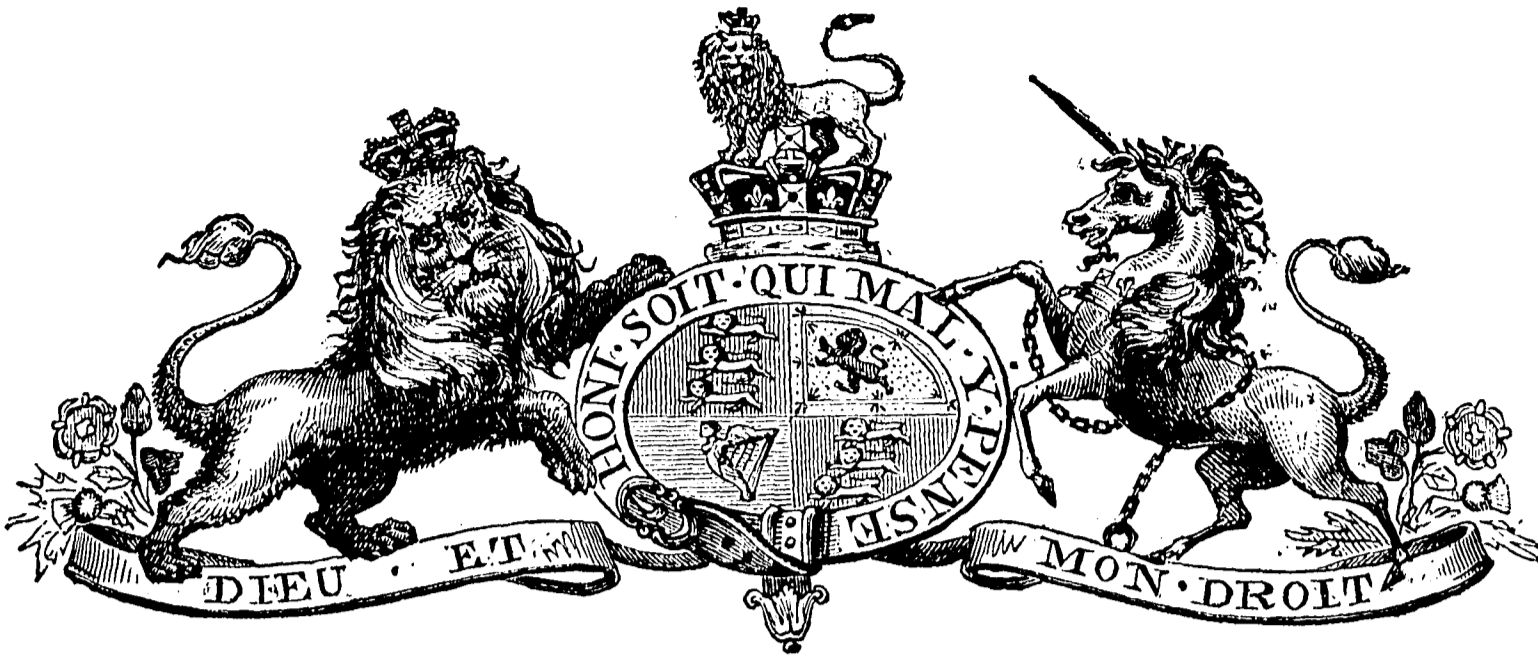

No. DCCCCLXXXVII.

An Act to sanction the issue and application of certain sums of money as Loans for Irrigation Works and Water Supply in the Country Districts and for other purposes.

[17th December 1888.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may for all purposes be cited as "*The Water Supply Loans Act 1888.*" Short title.

2. The Governor in Council may grant as loans for irrigation works and water supply purposes to the Corporations named in the First Part of the Schedule hereto any sum or sums not exceeding the amount set forth in the said part opposite to the name of such Corporations respectively. The sums specified in the Second Part of the Schedule hereto may be respectively expended for the purposes therein mentioned. The Treasurer of Victoria is hereby authorized to issue such sums accordingly not exceeding in the whole Two hundred and sixty-four thousand pounds from that portion of "*The Railway Loan Account 1885*" appropriated by the First Schedule to "*The Railway Loan Act 1885*" "for irrigation works and water supply in country districts to be expended in such manner as Parliament shall direct."
