An Act to amend the *University Act* 1958 in relation to the Appointment of Pro-Vice-Chancellors and Deans of Faculties.

[5th December, 1961.]

PE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :---

- 1. (1) This Act may be cited as the University (Officers) Act Short title 1961.
- (2) In this Act the University Act 1958 as amended is referred Principal Act. to as the Principal Act.

- 2. The Principal Act shall be amended as follows:
  - (a) In sub-section (1) of section five for the words ss. 5, 15. "thirty-three members" there shall be substituted the As to appointment, words "thirty-four members";

- (b) For paragraph (f) of sub-section (1) of section five pro-vice-chancellors. there shall be substituted the following paragraph:—
- "(f) the vice-chancellor, the two pro-vice-chancellors, the Director of Education and the chairman of the

advisorv

- advisory committee appointed under the Agricultural Colleges Act 1958 shall be members ex officio; " and
- (c) At the end of section fifteen there shall be inserted the following sub-section:—
- "(3) (a) Without limiting the generality of sub-section (1) of section the council may annually this pro-vice-chancellors one of whom shall be the chairman of the professorial board.
- (b) Subject to this Act, each of the pro-vice-chancellors shall as such have such powers and duties as are conferred or imposed upon him by statutes or regulations of the University."

3. For paragraph (b) of sub-section (1) of section twenty-nine of the Principal Act there shall be substituted the following paragraphs:—

As to appointment or election of deans of faculties.

- "(b) a dean of each faculty shall pursuant to and in accordance with statutes of the University from time to time as occasion arises be-
  - (i) appointed by the council; or
  - (ii) elected by the members of the faculty from their own number; and

As to regulation of proceedings of faculties. (c) each faculty may subject to the statutes and regulations of the University regulate its own proceedings."
