An Act to amend the University Act 1958.

[3rd December, 1963.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

Short title.

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *University (Amendment)* Act 1963.

Principal Act No. 6405 as amended by No. 6502. (2) The *University Act* 1958 as amended is in this Act referred to as the Principal Act.

Amendment of No. 6405 s. 33.

- 2. Section thirty-three of the Principal Act shall be amended as follows:—
  - (a) In sub-section (1)—

Free places for students in training at teachers' colleges.

Persons in employment of Government.

Free places.

(i) in paragraph (d) for the words "the teachers' college" there shall be substituted the words "a teachers' college";

(ii) in paragraph (e) for the words "ten persons" there shall be substituted the words "twenty persons"; and

(iii) in paragraph (f) for the words "fifty other persons" there shall be substituted the words "sixty other persons";

(b) in ·

- (b) In paragraph (a) of sub-section (4) for the expression Regulations. in paragraphs (c) and (e)" there shall be substituted the expression "in paragraphs (c) (d) and (e)";
- (c) After sub-section (4) there shall be inserted the following sub-section :-

"(4A) Without limiting the generality of the provisions of Agreement paragraph (c) of sub-section (4) of this section any form of provision for agreement prescribed pursuant thereto may contain a provision payment of penalty for that in the event of a breach by him of any obligation under the agreement the person recommended or nominated for a course shall pay to the Minister a sum not exceeding the total amount which, if he had not been recommended or nominated for a course. he would have had to pay to the University for lectures and examinations in that course; and where a person who has entered into an agreement containing such a provision fails to perform any obligation on his part thereunder the said sum shall be recoverable by the Minister according to the terms of the agreement in addition to any other amount which may be lawfully recoverable by the Minister thereunder or for a breach thereof notwithstanding that a smaller sum or that no sum has been paid or is payable by the Minister to the University in respect of that person."
