

No. 1832.

An Act to amend the Water Acts so far as relates to the Condah Swamp Lands.

[6th April, 1903.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the Water Act 1903, and shall be short title and read and construed as one with the Water Acts, which Acts and this construction. Act may be cited together as the Water Acts.

2. So far only as regards allotments of land within the area Lessee of Condah known as the Condah Swamp lands any person who has been granted by the Governor in Council and is the holder of a lease from the Crown for a term of twenty-one years of any such allotment shall for the No. 1749 s. 131. purposes of Part III. of the Water Act 1890 as amended by the Water Act 1900 be deemed and taken to be the owner of such allotment; provided however that any petition by owners of land to the Governor in Council praying for the constitution of the whole or any part of such Swamp lands as an Irrigation and Water Supply District and for the appointment and creation of a Trust therein must be signed by owners of land a majority of whom are owners of land other than holders of leases as aforesaid.
