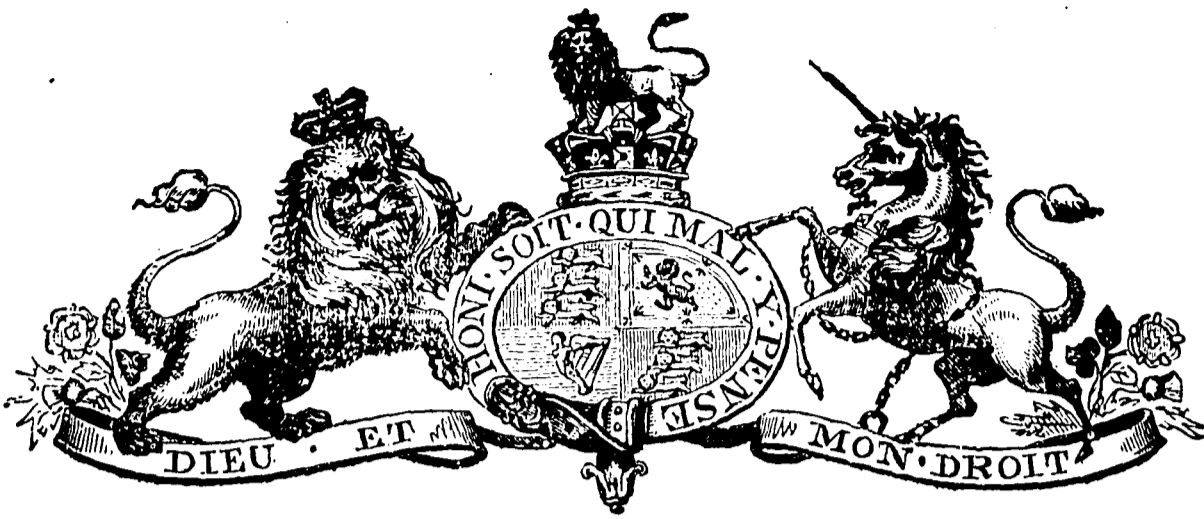

An Act to revoke the Permanent Reservation of certain Land in the Parish of Wombat.

[22nd December, 1903.]

WHEREAS by an Order in Council dated the twenty-fourth day of April One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two the land described in Part I. of the Schedule to this Act was reserved from sale permanently for the preservation and growth of timber : And whereas of the land so reserved the portion described in Part II. of the Schedule to this Act is not required for the purposes for which the same was reserved and it is expedient that the reservation of such portion should be revoked in order that the land comprised therein may be reserved from sale permanently as a site for a Mechanics' Institute and Free Library: Be it therefore enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):—

1. This Act may be cited as the *Wombat Land Act* 1903.

2. The said recited Order in Council dated the twenty-fourth day of April One thousand eight hundred and eighty-two by which certain land described in Part I. of the Schedule to this Act was reserved from sale permanently for the preservation and growth of timber shall so far only as the said Order in Council relates to the land in the County of Talbot Parish of Wombat described in Part II. of the Schedule to this Act be and the same is hereby revoked and the land described in the said Part II. shall be deemed to be and may be dealt with as unalienated land of the Crown.

LAND PERMANENTLY RESERVED BY ORDER IN COUNCIL OF THE 24TH APRIL, 1882,
FOR THE PRESERVATION AND GROWTH OF TIMBER, VIDE GOVERNMENT GAZETTE
28TH APRIL, 1882, PAGE 947.

Sixty-three thousand acres, more or less, counties of Talbot, Dalhousie, Bourke,
and Grant, parishes of Bullarook, Wombat, Bullarto, Glenlyon, Coliban, Trentham,
Blackwood, Moorarbool East, Moorarbool West, Korweinguboora, and Dean, as described
in *Gazette* of 10th March, 1882, pages 616, 617, and 618.

PART II.

PORTION OF WHICH THE PERMANENT RESERVATION IS TO BE REVOKED.

One rood twenty-two perches and four-tenths, county of Talbot, parish of Wombat,
being special allotment 4, at Leonard's Hill: Commencing at the south-east angle of the
allotment, being a point on the west side of the Ballan and Daylesford road; bounded
thence by a road bearing west three chains seventy-seven links; thence by allotment 5,
bearing north one chain; thence by allotment 3, bearing east four chains four links; and
thence by the Ballan and Daylesford road aforesaid, bearing S. 15° W. one chain three
and a half links to the point of commencement.
