An Act to amend the *West Melbourne Market Land Act 1956*.

[31st October, 1961.]

WHEREAS by the *West Melbourne Market Land Act 1956* it was provided that certain land in the Parish of Dousta Galla described in the Schedule to that Act in two separate portions might upon completion of the payment of the purchase price as therein provided be granted in fee simple to the Lord Mayor Councillors and Citizens of the City of Melbourne subject to such conditions reservations and restrictions as the Governor in Council might think fit and in particular to the condition that the said land should at all times be used as and for a site for a market and for other municipal purposes :

And whereas the Melbourne and Metropolitan Board of Works in exercise of its powers under the *Town and Country Planning Act 1958* has widened and altered the position of a road separating the two portions of the said land separately described as aforesaid thereby altering the area and boundaries of the said land and it is expedient that the said land should be re-defined accordingly :

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament

Short title.

1. This Act may be cited as the *West Melbourne Market Land (Amendment) Act 1961*.

Schedule.

2. For the description of land in the Schedule to the *West Melbourne Market Land Act 1956* there shall be substituted the following description :—

“Forty-nine acres two roods twenty-three perches, Parish of Doutta Galla, County of Bourke being allotments 10 and 10A, section 1B in the two portions separately described as follows :—

(1) Thirty-eight acres two roods thirty-one perches being allotment 10 : Commencing at the south-eastern angle of allotment 11 section 1B ; bounded thence by that allotment bearing $0^{\circ} 5'$ one thousand five hundred and one and two-tenths links ; by lines bearing $90^{\circ} 33'$ one thousand one hundred and eighty-eight links and $107^{\circ} 15'$ one thousand eight hundred and twenty-three and five-tenths links ; by a road bearing $180^{\circ} 5'$ six hundred and eighty and two-tenths links and $225^{\circ} 5'$ three hundred and eighty-five and six-tenths links, and thence by Footscray-road bearing $270^{\circ} 5'$ two thousand six hundred and fifty-eight links to the point of commencement.

(2) Ten acres three roods thirty-two perches being allotment 10A : Commencing at a point bearing $107^{\circ} 15'$ one hundred and ninety and three-tenths links from the north-eastern angle of allotment 10 ; bounded thence by lines bearing $107^{\circ} 15'$ one thousand six hundred and fifty-three and nine-tenths links and south-easterly five hundred and seventy links in an arc of a circle with centre lying five hundred and eleven and one-tenth links south-westerly, and with chord bearing $139^{\circ} 12'$ five hundred and forty and nine-tenths links ; by Footscray-road bearing $270^{\circ} 5'$ one thousand six hundred and sixty-one and five-tenths links, and thence by a road bearing $315^{\circ} 5'$ three hundred and eighty-five and six-tenths links and $0^{\circ} 5'$ six hundred and twenty-four links to the point of commencement.”
