An Act relating to certain Land vested in the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board in the City of Box Hill.

[29th November, 1960.]

Preamble.

W HEREAS the land described in the Schedule to this Act is part of an area of land known as "Wattle Park" which by virtue of the *Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Act* 1958 is vested in the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board (hereinafter referred to as "the Board") for the purposes of a park subject to and for the purposes of that Act and is part of the tramway undertakings of the Board :

And whereas the Mayor Councillors and Citizens of the City of Box Hill desire to obtain the land described in the said Schedule for the purposes of a highway and are prepared to purchase the said land at the price of Two thousand pounds :

And whereas it is expedient to authorize the Board to sell the said land accordingly :

Be it therefore enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say) :--

1. This Act may be cited as the Wattle Park Land Act 1960.

2. The Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board is hereby Authority to Melbourne and authorized to sell the land described in the Schedule to this Act Metropolitan to the Mayor Councillors and Citizens of the City of Box Hill Ind in Schedule to the sum of Two thousand pounds.

SCHEDULE.

Land which may be sold by the Melbourne and Metropolitan Tramways Board pursuant to this Act.

Three roods or thereabouts being Part of Crown Allotment B of Portion 41, Parish of Nunawading, County of Bourke and being part of the land described in Certificate of Title, Volume 3010, Folio 601859 : Commencing at the south-western corner of the intersection of Elgar-road and Riversdale-road, in the City of Box Hill, thence south along the western boundary of Elgar-road bearing 180 degrees for 295 feet ; thence for 75 feet 11 inches along the arc of a circle whose chord is 74 feet and bears 337 degrees 34 minutes, and whose centre lies south-westerly 96 feet 11 inches ; thence for 75 feet 11 inches along the arc of a circle whose chord is 74 feet and bears 292 degrees 41 minutes and whose centre lies south-westerly 96 feet 11 inches ; thence easterly along the southern boundary of Riversdale-road bearing 90 degrees 15 minutes for 295 feet to the commencing point.
