An Act to sanction the Issue and Application of Loan Money for Works and other Purposes relating to Irrigation Water Supply Drainage Flood Protection and River Improvement.

## [15th December, 1953.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):-

1. This Act may be cited as the Water Supply Loan short utle. Application Act 1953.

2. From the Loan Fund there may be issued and applied Issue and the several amounts specified in the Schedule to this Act in £15,000,000 column headed "Proposed Provision" for the Fund for  $\mathbf{the}^{-}$ respective works and purposes specified opposite thereto, specified in Schedule. not exceeding Fifteen million pounds in all.

3. Notwithstanding anything in any Water Supply No loan Loan Application Act in force before the commencement of this Act no money shall by virtue of any such Act be expended out of the Loan Fund for works and purposes relating to irrigation water supply drainage flood protection or river improvement except pursuant to and to the extent authorized by this Act.
