## No. 5418.

An Act to authorize the Raising of Money for Irrigation Works, Water Supply Works, Drainage Flood Protection and River Improvement Works in Country Districts and Works under the River Murray Waters Acts, and to sanction the Issue and Application of the Money so raised and of other Money available for such purposes under Loan Acts or in the State Loans Repayment Fund, and for other purposes.

# [15th November, 1949.]

BE it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Victoria in this present Parliament assembled and by the authority of the same as follows (that is to say):-

- 1. This Act may be cited as the Water Supply Loan short title. and Application Act 1949.
- 2. (1) For the purposes of this Act the Governor in Power to raise Council—
  - (a) may from time to time increase the amount of stock known as the Victorian Government Stock erected under the authority of the Victorian No. 1468. Government Stock Act 1896 by an additional amount not exceeding in the whole Six million four hundred thousand pounds; or
  - (b) may issue debentures for the whole or any portion of such sum in lieu of increasing stock as aforesaid—

all of which stock and debentures and interest thereon respectively at such rate or rates as the Governor in Council may fix shall be chargeable upon the consolidated revenue of Victoria.

(2) All provisions of the Victorian Government Stock Application of Victorian Acts with regard to the inscription issue management Government stock Acts redemption payment of interest on and transfer of stock Nos. 1468, 2403, 3053, 3053, 3297, 3544.

- 6. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part III. of the Loans to Mildura Irrigation and Water Trusts Act 1928 the Governor Trusts. in Council may advance on account of any loan to each No. 3735 Part III. trust named in the Second Part of the Schedule to this second Part of Schedule. Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Second Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such trust.

- (2) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding sub-section the Governor in Council within six months after the date on which any such advance is made may on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine what part, if any, of such advance shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability for that part shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be advanced pursuant to the provisions of Part III. of the Mildura Irrigation and Water Trusts Act 1928.
- 7. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part VII. of the Loans to local Water Act 1928 the Governor in Council may advance on bodies. account of any loan to each local governing body named No. 3801 Part VII. in the Third Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or Third Part of Schedule. sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Third of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such local governing body.

- 8. (1) Notwithstanding anything in the Geelong Waterworks and Sewerage Act 1928 or in the Local Government Act 1946 the Governor in Council may advance on account of any loan to any authority named in the Fourth Part of the Schedule to this Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Fourth Part of the said Schedule in the column headed "Proposed Provision" opposite to the name of such authority in all respects as if such authority were an authority within the meaning of the Water Act 1928.
- (2) Any sum so advanced to any such authority shall be expended on the improvement and extension of water supply works within the urban centre of such authority.
- (3) Any sum so advanced to any such authority shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability therefor shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of such authority.

- 9. (1) Pursuant to the provisions of Part IV. of the River Improvement Act 1948 the Governor in Council may advance to any river improvement trust or public authority within the meaning of that Act any sum or sums not exceeding the amount specified in the Fifth Part of the Schedule to this Act in the column headed "Proposed Provision".
- (2) Any sum so advanced to any such trust or authority shall be expended on such river improvement works as are approved by the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission.
  - (3) Notwithstanding

- (3) Notwithstanding anything in sub-section (1) of this section the Governor in Council within six months after the date on which any such advance is made to any such trust or authority may on recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply determine what part, if any, of such advance shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability for that part shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of such trust or authority.
- 10. The sum specified in the Sixth Part of the Expenditure Schedule to this Act in the column headed "Proposed under under Provision" may be expended by the State Rivers and of Schedule. Water Supply Commission for the purposes mentioned in the said Sixth Part.

11. (1) The sum specified in the Seventh Part of the Schedule to this Act in the column headed "Proposed under Provision" may be expended under and pursuant to the Seventh Part of Schedule. River Murray Waters Acts.

- 12. - (2) Any sum so expended shall be charged to the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account and the liability therefor shall be borne by the State accordingly and shall not be deemed to be a liability of any authority.
- (3) Notwithstanding anything in the last preceding sub-section the Governor in Council on the recommendation of the Minister of Water Supply may from time to time by Order adjust any expenditure made under sub-section (1) of this section by transferring from the State to any district or division concerned the liability for such amount of any such expenditure as the Governor in Council considers reasonable having regard to the development of such district or division; and thereupon the liability for any amount so transferred shall be transferred out of the Capital Expenditure Borne by the State Account

and be charged in the books of the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission to such district or division and be a liability of the appropriate authority accordingly.

Rate of sinking fund contribution in respect of loan liability applicable to item 15 of the Eighth Part of Schedule.

(4) In respect of the amount of loan liability which is applicable to the issue and application by this Act of the sum specified in item 15 of the Eighth Part of the Schedule to this Act for the works and purposes specified in that item, the rate of sinking fund contribution payable out of the consolidated revenue (which is hereby to the necessary extent appropriated accordingly) to the National Debt Sinking Fund in each and every financial year for a period sufficient to provide for the redemption of such amount of loan liability as aforesaid shall be Fifteen shillings per centum of such amount of loan liability.

13. The works specified in the Eighth Part of the Schedule to this Act, other than those which have by some Act of Parliament passed before the commencement of this Act been declared to be National or State works flood protection or river water supply drainage improvement or are described in the Third Schedule to the Water Act 1905 as State works of water supply, are hereby declared to be State works of water supply drainage flood protection or river improvement (as the case may be) within the meaning of the Water Acts; and the State Rivers and Water Supply Commission is hereby authorized and directed to construct and carry out all works specified in the Eighth Part of the Schedule to this Act.

Notwithstanding anything contained in any Water Supply Loans Application Act in force before commencement of this Act no money shall by virtue of any such Water Supply Loans Application Act be expended out of any loan funds for loans to waterworks trusts or local governing bodies or river improvement authorities or other public authorities or for or towards any irrigation works or water supply works or for drainage or flood protection or river improvement works or for the purchase or acquisition of plant or machinery or for works under the River Murray Waters Acts other than such as are specified respectively in the Schedule to this Act and to the extent mentioned therein in the column
