Economic Development (Repeal) Act 1994

Act No. 5/1994

Version as at 1 July 1997

The Parliament of Victoria enacts as follows:

1. Purpose

The purpose of this Act is to repeal the **Economic Development Act 1981**.

2. Commencement

This Act comes into operation on the day on which it receives the Royal Assent.

3. Repeal

The **Economic Development Act 1981** is repealed.

4. Savings

- (1) Despite the repeal of the **Economic Development Act 1981**, the repeal does not affect the operation, continuity or effect of any grant, loan, agreement, order or declaration made or given under that Act and that Act continues to apply in respect thereof as if it had not been repealed.
- (2) This section is in addition to and not in derogation from the **Interpretation of Legislation Act 1984**.
