**AN ACT to amend the Main Roads Act (Funds
Appropriation) Act, 1955.**

[Assented to 8th October, 1959.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Main Roads Act (Funds Appropriation) Act Amendment Act, 1959.*

and citation.

(2) In this Act the Main Roads Act (Funds Appropriation) Act, 1955, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the *Main Roads Act (Funds Appropriation) Act, 1955-1959.*

amended.

2. Section two of the principal Act is amended by—

- (a) deleting the word, “and” in the last line; and
- (b) adding after the figures, “1954” in the last line, the passage, “, 73 of 1954 and 6 of 1955.”

S. 4
amended.

3. Section four of the principal Act is amended by—

- (a) substituting for the passage, “1950 (No. 57 of 1954 of the Commonwealth)” in lines two and three of the interpretation, “Commonwealth Act,” the passage, “1959 (No. 39 of 1959 of the Commonwealth)”;
- (b) substituting for the interpretation, “prescribed years” the following interpretation—

“prescribed years” means each year during the period of five years commencing on the first day of July, one thousand nine hundred and fifty-nine;

and

- (c) substituting for the figures, “1954” in the last line of the interpretation, “principal Act,” the figures, “1955.”

amended.

4. Section seven of the principal Act is amended by substituting for the word, “fifty-nine” being the last word in the section, the word, “sixty-four.”
