

METROPOLITAN REGION TOWN PLANNING SCHEME.

No. 7 of 1970.

**AN ACT to amend Section 37A of the Metropolitan
Region Town Planning Scheme Act, 1959-1969.**

[Assented to 29th April, 1970.]

BE it enacted by the Queen's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Council and the Legislative Assembly of Western Australia, in this present Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. (1) This Act may be cited as the *Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act Amendment Act, 1970.*

(2) In this Act the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act, 1959-1969, is referred to as the principal Act.

(3) The principal Act as amended by this Act may be cited as the Metropolitan Region Town Planning Scheme Act, 1959-1970.

Amendment
to s. 37A.
(Power of
Authority to
acquire cer-
tain land.)

2. Section 37A of the principal Act is amended
by adding after subsection (4) a subsection as
follows—

(4a) For the purpose referred to in sub-
section (4) of this section the Authority may,
with the approval of the Governor and by
agreement with the owner of any land which—

(a) is included in an Improvement Plan;
and

(b) has not been acquired by the Authority
pursuant to this section,

construct, repair, rehabilitate or otherwise
improve any buildings, works, improvements or
facilities that are on the land. .
