JUDGE'S SENTENCING NOTES

I am satisfied that this case is one with a quite exceptional background such that a discharge without conviction under s.19 of the Criminal Justice Act is appropriate. That course is one which the informant readily agrees with - subject, however, to the payment of the informant's costs of \$7,054.86. The discharge will be granted with that condition. The defendant has co-operated in various steps which have been recorded in a Memorandum of Consent filed with the Court, and given the background of the memorandum and all that was stated to me at an earlier hearing last year, I am satisfied, as indicated, that the appropriate course in this proceeding is to grant the discharge under s.19, subject to payment of the prosecution's costs as noted.
