The Application

Johnsonville Club Incorporated applies for an on-site Special Licence in respect of premises situated at 1 Norman Lane, Johnsonville, Wellington known as the "Johnsonville Club" to cater for a private function.

The event is for a 21st birthday celebration and there will be approximately 95 people in attendance aged from 18 to 75 years. There will be speeches, dancing and supper provided to the friends and family of the birthday woman.

Substantive food options and low and non-alcoholic drinks will be available at all times.

The following days and hours are sought: Saturday the 16th of January 2016 7.30pm to 12 midnight.

REASONS FOR THE DECISION

The applicant has previously operated Special Licences without incident and has provided a Host Responsibility Policy that details the measures that will be undertaken with regard to the responsible sale and supply of alcohol and that harm will be minimised.

The comprehensive report of the Inspector indicates that the amenity and good order of the locality will not be adversely affected by more than a minor extent.

Neither the Police nor the Medical Officer of Health raise any matters in opposition.

The application was not required to be publicly notified and no opposition or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly, I deal with the matter on the papers.

I am satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in s.142 of the Act.

DECISION

The District Licensing Committee Chairman, acting pursuant to the Sale and Supply of Alcohol Act 2012 **grants** an application by Johnsonville Club Inc for an on-site Special Licence for the premises at 1 Norman Lane, Johnsonville known as the Johnsonville Club, subject to the following conditions.

Conditions:

- 1. Alcohol may be sold or supplied for consumption on the premises only on the following days and hours: Saturday the 16th of January 2016 7.30pm to 12 midnight.
- 2. Drinking water is to be provided to patrons free of charge from a water supply prominently situated on the premises.
- 3. A certificated manager must be on duty at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol;
- 4. Food must be available for consumption on the premises at all times the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, in accordance with the sample menu supplied with the application for this licence or menu variations of a similar range and standard;
- 5. The licensee must have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale and supply of alcohol, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic and low-alcohol beverages;
- 6. The Licensee must display signage as follows:
 - a. At every point of sale detailing restrictions on the sale and supply of alcohol to minors and intoxicated persons;

- b. A copy of the licence attached to the premises so as to be easily read by persons attending the premises; and
- c. A sign prominently displayed at the premises, which identifies by name the manager for the time being on duty.
- 7. The licensee must provide information and advice about forms of transport available to patrons from the licensed premises.
