MEMORANDUM BY CASEY J.

Having discussed this with Counsel in Chambers, I accept that for the reasons set out in Mr Finnigan's memorandum of 27th September there is a right of equitable set-off against the First Defendant notwithstanding my misunderstanding about the identify of the debentureholder. I therefore correct my further judgment of 17th September 1984 by allowing the equitable set off of \$5,500 against the First Defendant for the purpose of calculating interest under the debenture.
