FURTHER JUDGMENT OF WILLIAMSON J.

The judgment delivered on the 8th July 1988 contains an error arising from an accidental slip. Page 17 of the judgment refers to interest being allowed from the 14th December 1985 rather than the 14th May 1985. As I stated, at page 15 of the judgment, I decided and intended that interest

be allowed from the 14th May 1985.

Accordingly the judgment is amended to read:

" Judgment will be entered for the Plaintiffs against the Defendants for the sum of \$9,551 together with interest at 11% from the 14th May 1985 until the date of judgment."
