The applications were duly advertised and no objection or notice of desire to be heard has been received. Accordingly we deal with the matters on the papers.

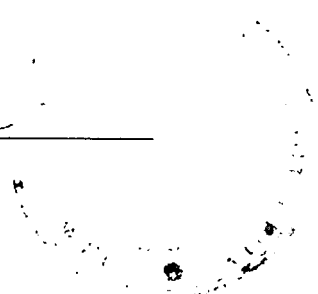
