DECISION

Public notification of the applications did not attract any objections or notices of desire to be heard. We deal with the matters on the papers.

The general nature of the business to be conducted under the on-licence is that of a restaurant, and under the off-licence that of a caterer in terms of s.51 of the Act.


We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard as set out in ss.13 and 35 of the Act, and we grant the applicant the on and off-licences sought. Copies of the licences setting out the conditions to which each is subject are attached to this decision.

The licences may issue immediately.

The applicant's attention is drawn to ss.25 and 48 of the Act obliging the holder of on and off-licences to display:-

1. A sign attached to the exterior of the premises, so as to be easily read by persons outside each principal entrance, stating the ordinary hours of business during which the premises will be open for the sale of liquor AND
2. A copy of each licence, and of the conditions of each licence, attached to the interior of the premises so as to be easily read by persons entering through each principal entrance.

Sections 7 and 114, Sale of Liquor Act 1989

PURSUANT to the Sale of Liquor Act 1989, KINSMAN HOLDINGS LIMITED is authorised to sell and supply liquor, on the premises situated at Ground Floor, 132 King Street, Palmerston North and known as "The Citadel", for consumption on the premises, to any person who is present on the premises for the purpose of dining and to allow the consumption of liquor on the premises by any such person.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised by the licensee (if an individual) or through a manager or manager appointed by the licensee in accordance with Part VI of the Act.

**CONDITIONS**

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises, at all times when the premises are open for the sale of liquor, a reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments.
- (b) Liquor may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:  
  
Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 3.00 am the following day
- (c) Food shall be available for consumption on the premises at all times when the premises are open for the sale of liquor in accordance with the menu submitted with the application for a licence or variations of that menu of similar range and standard.

**THE LICENSED PREMISES**

In terms of Regulation 7 of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1990 the sale, supply or consumption of liquor is authorised in the ground floor of premises. The premises located at 132 King Street, Palmerston North are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by Tribunals Division on 1 October 1998.

**DISPLAY OF LICENCE AND PRINCIPAL ENTRANCE/S**

A copy of this licence shall be displayed at the principal entrance to the premises. The entrance from King Street is designated as the principal entrance.

**DURATION**

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence shall continue in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.

## Sections 29 and 114, Sale of Liquor Act 1989

Section 51 applies to this licence.

**KINSMAN HOLDINGS LIMITED**, carrying on business as a caterer, is authorised to deliver liquor from the premises situated at Ground Floor, 132 King Street, Palmerston North and known as "The Citadel" and sell it on any other premises for consumption on those other premises by persons attending any reception, function, or other social gathering promoted by any person or association of persons other than the holder of this licence.

The authority conferred by this licence shall be exercised by the licensee (if an individual) or through a manager or managers appointed by the licensee in accordance with Part VI of the Act.

### CONDITIONS

This licence is subject to the following conditions:

- (a) Liquor may be delivered from the premises specified in the licence and sold on any other premises only on the following days and during the following hours:  
  
Monday to Sunday 7.00 am to 3.00 am the following day to persons attending any reception, function or other social gathering promoted by any person or association of persons other than the holder of this licence.
- (b) The licensee shall have available for consumption on the premises on which liquor is being sold-
  - (i) A reasonable range of non-alcoholic refreshments; and
  - (ii) Food appropriate to the particular function or gathering being catered for.
- (c) The licensee shall ensure that the provisions of the Act relating to the sale and supply of liquor to prohibited persons are observed.

### THE LICENSED PREMISES

In terms of Regulation 10 of the Sale of Liquor Regulations 1990 the sale or delivery of liquor is authorised in or from the ground floor of the premises. The premises located at 132 King Street, Palmerston North are more precisely identified as outlined in a plan date stamped as received by Tribunals Division on 1 October 1998.

### DURATION

Subject to the requirements of the Act relating to the payment of fees, and to the provisions of the Act relating to the suspension and cancellation of licences, this licence shall continue in force -

- (a) Until the close of the period of 1 year commencing with the date of its issue; or
- (b) If an application for the renewal of the licence is duly made, until the application is determined; or
- (c) If the licence is renewed, until the close of the period for which it is renewed.
