DECISION

This is an application by Max Robinson Kerikeri Auctions Limited for an off-licence pursuant to s.29 of the Act to be endorsed in accordance with s.52 of the Act as the applicant holds an Auctioneer's Licence.

An application of this nature does not require public notification, or reports in terms of s.33 and there is no right of objection (see s.52).

Accordingly, we deal with the matter on the papers.

The requirements of the Act have been met. Details of the Auctioneer's Licence No. 27851 have been submitted.

We are satisfied as to the matters to which we must have regard and we authorise the issue of an off-licence pursuant to s.29 of the Act, endorsed pursuant to s.52(1) for the purpose of auctioning liquor.

The licence may issue immediately and will be subject to the following conditions:

1. No liquor shall be sold or delivered on any Sunday or on Good Friday or Christmas Day.
2. Liquor may be sold only on the following days and during the following hours:

Monday to Saturday      8.00 am to 10.00 pm
