DECISION


This is an application by Leah Te Hitau Kingi-Meek pursuant to s.123 of the Act for renewal of a Club Manager's Certificate.

The application was opposed by the Police on the ground that the applicant was convicted on 10 August 1999 on a charge of theft as a servant. In the District Court at Pukekohe, she was ordered to pay a reparation of \$8,000 and perform 200 hours community service.
