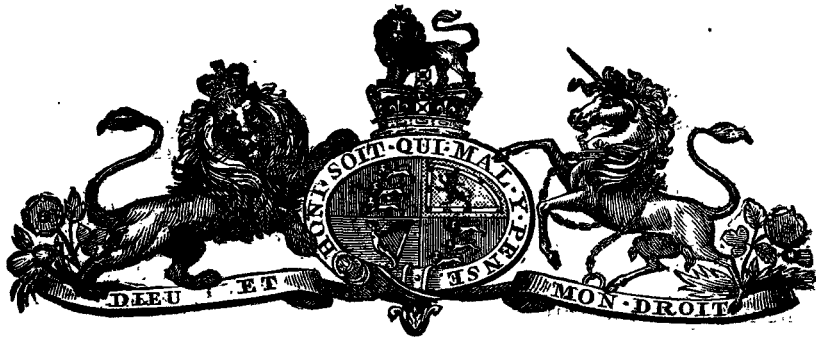

AN ACT to vest certain Lands at Blueskin in Trustees for the Recreation of the Inhabitants of the District of Blueskin and the surrounding Districts.

[14th October, 1876.]

WHEREAS under and by virtue of section twenty-seven of "The Abolition of Provinces Act, 1875," the Superintendent of Otago recommended His Excellency the Governor to set aside and reserve the lands hereinafter mentioned and described in the Schedule hereto as a reserve for recreation for the use of the inhabitants of Blueskin and the surrounding districts: And whereas it is expedient to provide for the management of the said reserve:

BE IT THEREFORE ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act shall be "The Blueskin Recreation Reserve Act, 1876."

2. The lands described in the Schedule hereto shall be and are hereby vested in William Augustus Dean Pitt, gentleman, Warrington; John Davie, merchant, Dunedin; Percival Clay Niel, merchant, Dunedin; James Green, gentleman, Blueskin; Thomas Quayle, gentleman, Blueskin; under the name of "The Blueskin Recreation Reserve Trust;" and such Trust shall be a corporation, and have all the powers of incorporated bodies.

3. It shall be lawful for the Governor to issue a grant from the

Blueskin Recreation Reserve.

Crown of the lands described in the Schedule hereto to the said Blueskin Recreation Reserve Trust (hereinafter called "the said Trust").

Trust may manage lands.

4. The said Trust may manage the said land as to the said Trust seems meet, but so that the said land shall be used for recreation purposes only for the inhabitants of the District of Blueskin and the surrounding districts.

New members of Trust.

5. If any member of the said Trust shall resign, or shall be absent for twelve months from the Province of Otago, or shall be adjudicated a bankrupt or insolvent, or take the benefit of any Act for the relief of debtors, or shall be convicted of any felony, he shall cease to be a member of the said Trust; and the Governor may, in case of such vacancy, or in case of the death of any member, appoint another or others in his place: Provided that in case of the establishment of a Municipal Council at Blueskin, such vacancy shall be filled up by vote of such Municipal Council.

Schedule.

SCHEDULE.

ALL that parcel of land in the Province of Otago, in the Colony of New Zealand, containing by admeasurement seventy-three (73) acres and three (3) roods, more or less, situate in the Waikouaiti District, being Section numbered sixty-eightA (68A), Block one (I.), on the map of the said district. Bounded towards the North and North-east by high watermark of Blueskin Bay, one thousand two hundred (1200) links; towards the East and South-east by Blueskin Bay, five thousand and forty (5040) links; towards the South-west by Blueskin Bay, two thousand five hundred (2500) links; and towards the North-west by Blueskin Bay, four thousand five hundred and fifty (4550) links; be all the aforesaid linkages more or less; and intersected by two arms of Blueskin Bay.
