AN ACT to amend the Coroners Act 1951.

Title.

[30 September 1954

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Coroners Amendment Act 1954, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Coroners Act 1951 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Section eight of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting the words "because the body has been destroyed or cannot be recovered", and substituting the words "because of the provisions of section fifteen of this Act".
