**An Act to amend the Companies Act 1955**

[27 October 1965]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title**—This Act may be cited as the Companies Amendment Act 1965, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Companies Act 1955 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

**2. Restriction on registration of companies by certain names**—(1) Section 31 of the principal Act is hereby amended by inserting in subsection (2), after paragraph (d), the following paragraph:

“(e) Contains the word ‘Ruakura’”.

(2) Section 31 of the principal Act is hereby further amended by adding to paragraph (d) of subsection (2) the word “or”.

**3. Rates of licence fees**—(1) Section 451 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from paragraph (a) of subsection (1) the words “one pound”, and substituting the words “two pounds”.

(2) This section shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-six.
