## The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

### 1 Title

This Act is the Crimes Amendment Act 2006.

### 2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

### 3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Crimes Act 1961.

### 4 Warrant to collect fine or other sum of money ordered to be paid

(1) Section 19C(2) is amended by inserting “or bailiff” after “constable”.

(2) Section 19C is amended by adding the following subsection:

“(3) In this section and section 19D, **bailiff** means a bailiff of a District Court; and includes any deputy bailiff and any person

acting as bailiff under section 15 of the District Courts Act 1947.”

## **5 Execution**

Section 19D is amended by inserting “or bailiff” after “constable”.
