The Parliament of New Zealand enacts as follows:

1 Title

This Act is the Crimes Amendment Act 2006.

2 Commencement

This Act comes into force on the day after the date on which it receives the Royal assent.

3 Principal Act amended

This Act amends the Crimes Act 1961.

4 Warrant to collect fine or other sum of money ordered to be paid

- (1) Section 19C(2) is amended by inserting "or bailiff" after "constable".
- (2) Section 19C is amended by adding the following subsection:
- "(3) In this section and section 19D, **bailiff** means a bailiff of a District Court; and includes any deputy bailiff and any person

acting as bailiff under section 15 of the District Courts Act 1947."
