2. Inquiries for purposes of civil aviation administration

1961, No. 77

An Act to amend the Civil Aviation Act 1948

[1 December 1961

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title—This Act may be cited as the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 1961, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil Aviation Act 1948* (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. Inquiries for purposes of civil aviation administration—The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 3B (as inserted by section 4 of the Civil Aviation Amendment Act 1960), the following section:

“3c. (1) The Minister may from time to time make, or appoint any other person or persons to make, such inquiries as he thinks necessary or expedient for the purpose of securing the improvement, development, and better regulation and administration of civil aviation and all matters incidental thereto.

“(2) For the purposes of this section the provisions of the Commissions of Inquiry Act 1908 shall, as far as they are applicable and with the necessary modifications, apply as if the Minister and every person appointed by him under this section were a Commission of Inquiry appointed under that Act.

“(3) No person shall be deemed to be employed in the service of Her Majesty for the purposes of the Public Service Act 1912 or of the Superannuation Act 1956 by reason of his having been appointed to make inquiries under subsection (1) of this section.”
