Title.

AN ACT to bring "The Counties Act, 1886," into Force within the Cheviot County. [7th August, 1893.]

Short Title.

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Cheviot County Act, 1893."

Counties Act may
be proclaimed

2. The Cheviot County shall be deemed to have been and to be a county wherein no part of "The Counties Act, 1886," has been in force, as if the said county had been named in section eight of the said Act as one of the counties excepted from the operation of the said Act.

The Governor may, without further authority than this Act, and whenever he shall think fit after the passing thereof, by Proclamation declare the day upon which "The Counties Act, 1886," shall come into force in the Cheviot County; and in the same or any subsequent Proclamation shall provide for the matters mentioned in section twenty-eight of the said Act in relation to new counties, and the election of the first Councils thereof.
