AN ACT to amend "The Criminal Code Act, 1893." Title.
[9th October, 1900.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Criminal Code Act 1893 Amendment Act, 1900." Short Title.
2. In this Act "incest" means carnal connection between— Interpretation.
 - (1.) Father and daughter;
 - (2.) Brother and sister, whether of the whole or half blood;
 - (3.) Son and mother;
 - (4.) Grandfather and granddaughter.
3. (1.) Every male person, being sixteen years of age or upwards, who commits incest is liable to ten years' imprisonment, with hard labour. Punishment of incest.
- (2.) Every female person of or over the age of sixteen years who commits incest is liable to ten years' imprisonment, with hard labour.
