An Act to amend the Civil List Act 1950.

Title.

[21 October 1955

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as the Civil List Amendment Short Title. Act 1955, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Civil List Act 1950 (hereinafter referred to 1950, No. 99 as the principal Act).

2. Section twenty-seven of the principal Act is hereby Royal amended by inserting, after subsection one, the following subsection:

"(1A) A Royal Commission shall be appointed for the purposes of this section within three months after the general election. date of every general election of members of Parliament."
