AN ACT to extend the Term of the Patent Rights acquired under Title.
"The Cyanide Process Gold-extraction Act, 1897."

[24th August, 1901.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. The Short Title of this Act is "The Cyanide Process Extension Act, 1901"; and it shall form part of and be read together with "The Cyanide Process Gold-extraction Act, 1897" (hereinafter called "the principal Act"). Short Title.

2. It is hereby declared that the term during which the patent rights acquired under the principal Act were protected under "The Patents, Designs, and Trade-marks Act, 1889," shall (notwithstanding anything in that Act) be extended until such time as it is notified in the *Gazette*, under section eighteen of the principal Act, that the total of the moneys received under the principal Act and paid into the Consolidated Fund is equal to the total of the moneys paid out of the Consolidated Fund under the same Act; and the provisions of the principal Act shall be construed accordingly.
