1. Short Title and commencement	

1967, No. 60

An Act to amend the Chattels Transfer Act 1924

[23 November 1967]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

1. Short Title and commencement—(1) This Act may be cited as the Chattels Transfer Amendment Act 1967, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Chattels Transfer Act 1924 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the first day of January, nineteen hundred and sixty-eight.

2. Fees—(1) The principal Act is hereby amended by inserting, after section 19, the following section:

“19A. (1) The Governor-General may from time to time, by Order in Council, make regulations prescribing the matters in respect of which fees are to be payable under this Act and the amount of those fees.

“(2) Any such regulations may—

“(a) Authorise the refund, remission, or reduction of any fee so prescribed:

“(b) Specify the circumstances in which any such refund, remission, or reduction may take place:

“(c) Confer on a Registrar the power to determine whether any fees should be refunded, remitted, or reduced.

“(3) Where any fee is payable in respect of any matter in accordance with any regulations made pursuant to this section a Registrar may refuse to do any act, to permit any search, or to allow any copy of any document to be made until the fee is paid.”

(2) The principal Act is hereby amended in the manner indicated in the Schedule to this Act.

(3) Section 3 of the Chattels Transfer Amendment Act 1950 is hereby repealed.

AMENDMENTS TO CHATTELS TRANSFER ACT 1924

Section Amended	Amendment
Section 2 	By omitting the definition of the term “prescribed fee”.
Section 11 	By repealing this section.
Section 14 	By repealing subsection (5).
Section 15 	By omitting the words “upon payment of the prescribed fee for every search against any one person”.
Section 16 	By omitting the word “office” wherever it occurs. By omitting the words “on payment of the prescribed fee”, and also the words “upon payment of the prescribed fee”.
Section 42 	By omitting from subsection (1) the words “and payment of the prescribed fee”.
Section 56 	By repealing subsection (2).
