AN ACT to amend the Emergency Regulations Act 1939. [5 December 1951]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1951, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Emergency Regulations Act 1939 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

2. (1) The emergency regulations specified in the First Schedule to this Act are hereby revoked as from the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one.

(2) The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regulations Continuance Act 1947 is hereby amended as from the thirty-first day of December, nineteen hundred and fifty-one, by repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations hereby revoked.

3. The Second Schedule to the Emergency Regu- Emergency lations Continuance Act 1947 (as amended by the last regulations preceding section) is hereby further amended by other repealing so much thereof as relates to the regulations specified in the Second Schedule to this Act (being regulations that have been revoked by other enactments).

4. The emergency regulations specified in the Third Emergency Schedule to this Act, unless they are sooner revoked by regulations continued in the Governor-General in Council or by any Act, shall force. continue in force until the thirty-first day of December. nineteen hundred and fifty-two, and shall then expire.

5. The Emergency Regulations Amendment Act 1950 Repeal. is hereby repealed.
