AN ACT to amend the Marriage Act, 1908.

Title.

[31st October, 1919.]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:—

1. This Act may be cited as the Marriage Amendment Act, 1919, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Marriage Act, 1908. Short Title.

2. Section six of the Marriage Amendment Act, 1915 (relating to notices in New Zealand of marriages to be contracted out of New Zealand), is hereby amended by inserting, after the reference to the Foreign Marriage Act, 1892 (Imperial), in subsection one, the words “or in any case of marriage between British subjects intended to be solemnized or contracted in the United Kingdom.” Section 6 of
