**An Act to amend the Manukau City Empowering (Farm  
Land Rating) Act 1969**      [20 October 1972]

BE IT ENACTED by the General Assembly of New Zealand in Parliament assembled, and by the authority of the same, as follows:

**1. Short Title and commencement**—(1) This Act may be cited as the Manukau City Empowering (Farm Land Rating) Amendment Act 1972, and shall be read together with and deemed part of the Manukau City Empowering (Farm Land Rating) Act 1969 (hereinafter referred to as the principal Act).

(2) This Act shall come into force on the 1st day of April 1973.

**2. Application for postponement**—(1) Section 3 of the principal Act is hereby amended by omitting from subsection (1) the expression “\$6,000”, and substituting the expression “\$18,000”.

(2) Section 4 of the principal Act is hereby consequentially amended by omitting from subsection (1) the expression “\$6,000”, and substituting the expression “\$18,000”.

**3. Postponement of portion of general rates**—Section 6 of the principal Act is hereby amended by repealing subsection (1), and substituting the following subsection:

“(1) Subject to section 7 of this Act and to subsection (2) of this section, where an application for postponement under section 3 of this Act has been granted for any rating period in respect of any farm land, payment of the general rate made and levied by the Council for that period in respect of that land shall be deemed to be postponed to the extent of such percentage as the Council from time to time by special order determines:

“Provided that payment of the general rate shall not be deemed to be postponed under this section beyond the extent at which the amount of the general rate the payment of which is not postponed is equal to the amount of the general rate that would be payable if the rateable value of that land were \$18,000.”
